SKI TRIPS

Just 18 days till the first day of Winter!

Who's still counting with me?

The ski season has started, western resorts are in full swing, and Snowshoe Mountain in WV and Seven Springs Resort in PA were able to open a few days earlier than scheduled, before Thanksgiving.

We are off to a BIG WHITE START with many resorts claiming this is the best start to the ski season since 2004. Schweitzer Idaho, our March 4-10th Ski Trip received 39 inches of snow in the last 8 days, and Steamboat Colorado, our mid-February Ski Trip, received 18 inches. Ski News Update

Steamboat's long-range expansion plans got real for visitors this season with the lower leg of its new Wild Blue Gondola opening.

Copper Mountain will be partying like it's 1972 as they celebrate 50 years. Additionally, a new 25,000 sq ft lodge restaurant, bar and cafeteria will open in 2023 at the top of American Eagle lift.

Whitefish is opening its first express six-seater chair. The Snow Ghost Express will run from the resort's base area to the summit of Inspiration Ridge in a mere 7 minutes!

Schweitzer has added chair lift capacity on their Stella Chair, the only six-person chair in Idaho, giving skiers even better access to the tree skiing and long groomers in the Outback Bowl.


