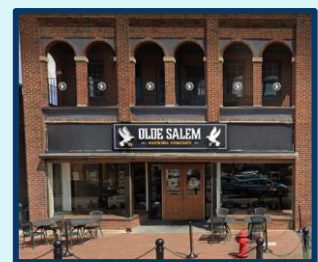

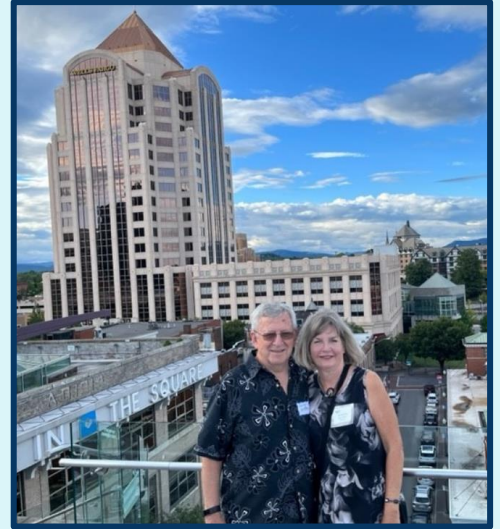

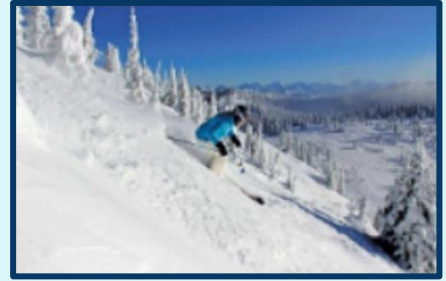

You will board the 429 ft **Royal Clipper Tall Ship**, with its 5 masts and 42 sails, and travel from Barbados throughout the Grenadine Islands. This tall ship offers the ultimate in seagoing experience with exquisite dining, spacious cabins, 3 swimming pools and a maximum of only 227 guests. It's an amazing adventure!

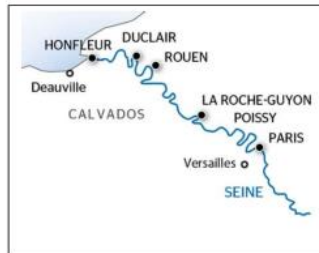

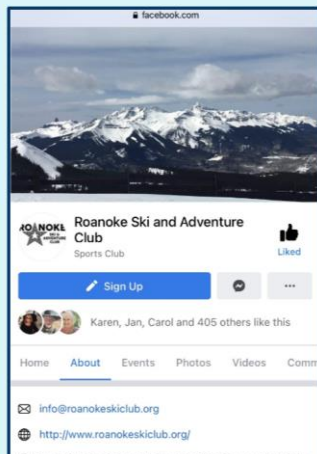

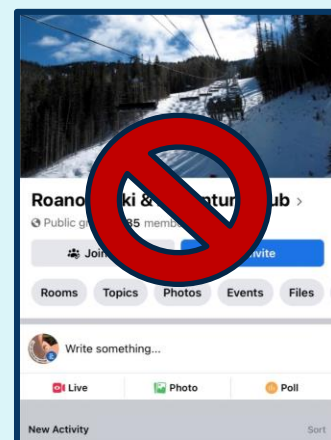
